- Reflect on a time when you challenged a belief or idea. What prompted you to act? Would you make the same decision again?
- Discuss an accomplishment or event, formal or informal, which marked your transition from childhood to adulthood within your culture, community, or family.
- FHS students possess an intellectual vitality. Reflect on an idea or experience that has been important to your intellectual development.
- What matters to you, and why?
- Tell about a personal quality, talent, accomplishment, contribution or experience that is important to you. What about this quality or accomplishment makes you proud and how does it relate to the person you are?
